  - Ask an adult to interview you about the book (questions are provided below).
  - Choose a part to read aloud to the adult.
  - Ask the adult to provide feedback about how well you read.
  - Have the adult sign your reading log.
  
3. When you have finished your quadrant reading log, turn it in and get a new log.
