

# Dots & Boxes Game

Students will play the game with a partner.

Each partnership will need:

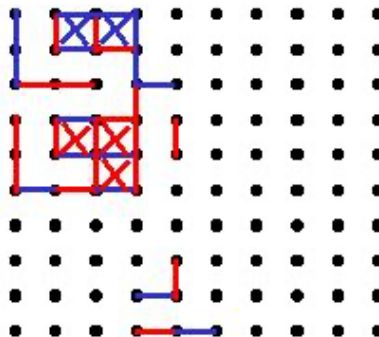
- 1 Dots and Boxes game board;
- 2 colored pens. (Each player will need a different color).

**Object of the Game:** Win the most boxes.

**Directions:**

- The youngest player goes first.
- Take turns drawing horizontal or vertical lines to connect the boxes.
- When you draw a line, read the word(s) on either side of the line.
- When you complete a box, draw an X in the box.
- Once all the dots have been connected, count the number of X's marked with each color.
- The person with the most X's is the winner
